Mike:

Here's what I found. There isn't a separate approval of the County's regional pond program. According to the attached email from Heather Mackey, the regional pond program was considered as part of CBLAD's review of the County's Bay Program in 1993. As such, CBLAB's original approval of the County's Bay Program in 1993 covers the regional pond program in existence at that time. I couldn't find any specific mention of the regional pond program in CBLAD's 1993 Staff Report associated with CBLAB's adopting resolution finding the County's Bay Program consistent with the Bay Act and Regulations. Therefore, the only documentation we have is the email. The email is sufficient for our purposes in making a determination that the facilities listed in the Regional Pond Program Report are permitted in the RPA without the need for an exception.

We have not, as yet, submitted any of the current watershed management plans to the state for review. So, for the time being, the only regional facilities allowed in the RPA as permitted uses are the ones in listed in the Regional Pond Program Report.
